RE: Support re Bumping into an MP / Time for Parties to Discuss Right to Die Legislation / Better Decorum in the House

Prime Minister Trudeau,

Just a short note of support to you.

To my eyes, it appeared that some MPs were trying to block the Conservative Whip from approaching the front of the House of Commons as a tactic to inhibit the voting to begin.

I perceive that you acted in such a way as to assist your fellow parliamentarian Mr. Brown, and that you inadvertently bumped into another MP (by accident).

You have apologized sincerely, and as a Canadian I accept that you apologized sincerely and that you acted in good faith. You have apologized 3 times, and it is enough. We accept it. Please don't apologize for this anymore.

As an outside comment, please don't unreasonably limit other parties' opinions on crucial bills such as the Right to Die legislation. We need many perspectives on this, and we need to get it right.

Can't we just approach the Supreme Court of Canada for a modest extension? I'm guessing it's not as simple as that but the date "June 6" seems so arbitrary to an ordinary Canadian like myself and it seems to have created a 'pressure-cooker' environment.

Please be assured that many of us out here are enjoying all the many good efforts and steps you and the Government of Canada have made to date in this Parliament.

I still believe that you are "Sunny Ways" to your core. Don't let overblown rhetoric about "violence against women" dampen your spirits (which I don't believe it is, and I believe that stating your accident as such is harmful to the seriousness of actual violence against women issues).

No need to write me back. I'm just sending you a note of support. I hope that under your leadership that you will find a way to foment better and more dignified and respectful decorum in the House. Maybe Parliamentarians need to participate in 5-minute workshops at the start of session to encourage people to consider better personal and professional conduct (and I am NOT singling out you in any way).
